A BILL

To allow the Coast Guard to consider the impacts of Hurricane Michael for the purpose of modifying contracts for offshore patrol cutters.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Restore Coast Guard
5 Capabilities Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. MODIFICATIONS TO CONTRACTS FOR OFFSHORE**
2 **PATROL CUTTERS PERMITTED BASED ON IM-**
3 **PACTS OF HURRICANE MICHAEL.**

4 Notwithstanding Public Law 85–804, the United
5 States Coast Guard is authorized to take into account the
6 impacts of Hurricane Michael for the purpose of modi-
7 fying, without consideration, but not exceeding the origi-
8 nal affordability requirement as set forth in section C of
9 the existing contract to construct Offshore Patrol Cutters
10 upon a determination that doing so would facilitate na-
11 tional security.

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
