3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “National Patient Iden-
5 tifier Repeal Act of 2019”.

6 **SEC. 2. REPEAL OF REQUIREMENT FOR UNIQUE HEALTH**
7 **IDENTIFIERS.**

8 Section 1173(b) of the Social Security Act (42 U.S.C.
9 1320d–2(b)) is repealed.
