A BILL

To require the United States Executive Director of the International Bank for Reconstruction and Development to oppose assistance by the Bank for any country that exceeds the graduation threshold of the Bank and is of concern with respect to religious freedom.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. OPPOSITION TO ASSISTANCE BY THE INTER-**
 2 **NATIONAL BANK FOR RECONSTRUCTION AND**
 3 **DEVELOPMENT FOR COUNTRIES THAT EX-**
 4 **CEED THE GRADUATION THRESHOLD AND**
 5 **ARE OF CONCERN FOR RELIGIOUS FREEDOM.**

6 The United States Governor of the International
 7 Bank for Reconstruction and Development shall instruct
 8 the United States Executive Director of the Bank to vote
 9 against, and to use the Executive Director's best efforts
 10 to deny, any loan or the extension of any financial or tech-
 11 nical assistance by the Bank to a country if—

12 (1) the gross national income per capita of the
 13 country exceeds, by more than 35 percent, the
 14 threshold for graduation from eligibility for assist-
 15 ance from the Bank;

16 (2) the reserves of the country exceed an
 17 amount equivalent to the value of goods and services
 18 imported into the country during the most recent
 19 12-month period for which data are available; and

20 (3) the country is designated—

21 (A) as a country of particular concern for
 22 religious freedom under clause (ii) of section
 23 402(b)(1)(A) of the International Religious
 24 Freedom Act of 1998 (22 U.S.C.
 25 6442(b)(1)(A)); or

- 1 (B) for placement on the special watch list
- 2 under clause (iii) of that section.
