A BILL

To amend the Food and Nutrition Act of 2008 to disqualify certain convicted felons from eligibility in the supplemental nutrition assistance program.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “No Welfare for Terror-
5 ists Act of 2020”.

6 **SEC. 2. DISQUALIFICATION OF CERTAIN CONVICTED FEL-**
7 **ONS.**

8 Section 6(r)(1)(A) of the Food and Nutrition Act of
9 2008 (7 U.S.C. 2015(r)(1)(A)) is amended—

- 1 (1) by redesignating clauses (iv) and (v) as
2 clauses (v) and (vi), respectively;
- 3 (2) by inserting after clause (iii) the following:
4 “(iv) an offense under chapter 113B
5 of title 18, United States Code;”;
- 6 (3) in clause (v) (as so redesignated), by insert-
7 ing “section” before “40002(a)”; and
- 8 (4) in clause (vi) (as so redesignated), by strik-
9 ing “or (iii)” and inserting “(iii), or (iv)”.

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
