1 **SECTION 1. SEVENTY-SEVEN-DAY EXTENSION OF AUTHOR-**
 2 **ITY TO ACCESS CERTAIN BUSINESS RECORDS**
 3 **FOR FOREIGN INTELLIGENCE AND INTER-**
 4 **NATIONAL TERRORISM INVESTIGATIONS AND**
 5 **FOR ROVING SURVEILLANCE.**

6 Section 102(b)(1) of the USA PATRIOT Improve-
 7 ment and Reauthorization Act of 2005 (Public Law 109–
 8 177; 50 U.S.C. 1805 note) is amended by striking “March
 9 15, 2020” and inserting “May 30, 2020”.

10 **SEC. 2. SEVENTY-SEVEN-DAY EXTENSION OF AUTHORITY**
 11 **FOR INDIVIDUAL TERRORISTS TO BE TREAT-**
 12 **ED AS AGENTS OF FOREIGN POWERS UNDER**
 13 **THE FOREIGN INTELLIGENCE SURVEIL-**
 14 **LANCE ACT OF 1978.**

15 Section 6001(b)(1) of the Intelligence Reform and
 16 Terrorism Prevention Act of 2004 (Public Law 108–458;
 17 50 U.S.C. 1801 note) is amended by striking “March 15,
 18 2020” and inserting “May 30, 2020”.

19 **SEC. 3. EFFECTIVE DATE.**

 21 effect on March 14, 2020.
