A BILL

To make a technical correction relating to the treatment of refunds of merchandise processing fees under the United States-Mexico-Canada Agreement Implementation Act.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. TECHNICAL CORRECTION RELATING TO RE-**
4 **FUNDS OF MERCHANDISE PROCESSING FEES.**

5 (a) RELIQUIDATION OF ENTRIES.—Section 205(a)(1)
6 of the United States-Mexico-Canada Agreement Imple-
7 mentation Act (Public Law 116–113) is amended by strik-
8 ing subparagraph (C) and inserting the following:

1 “(C) by striking ‘for which’ and inserting
2 ‘, or section 202 of the United States-Mexico-
3 Canada Agreement Implementation Act, for
4 which’; and”.

5 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
6 subsection (a) shall take effect as if included in the enact-
7 ment of the United States-Mexico-Canada Agreement Im-
8 plementation Act.

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
