3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “State and Local
5 Coronavirus Relief Fund Extension Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. EXTENSION.**

2 Section 601(d)(3) of the Social Security Act (42
3 U.S.C. 801(d)(3)) is amended by striking “December 30,
4 2020” and inserting “December 31, 2021”.

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
