A BILL

To permit voluntary economic activity.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Antitrust Freedom Act
5 of 2020”.

6 **SEC. 2. VOLUNTARY ECONOMIC COORDINATION BY INDIVIDUALS.**

8 The Sherman Act (15 U.S.C. 1 et seq.), the Clayton
9 Act (15 U.S.C. 12 et seq.), and section 5 of the Federal
10 Trade Commission Act (15 U.S.C. 45) shall not be con-
11 strued to prohibit, ban, or otherwise extend to any vol-
12 untary economic coordination, cooperation, agreement, or

- 1 other association, compact, contract, or covenant entered
- 2 into by or between any individual or group of individuals.
