flexibility analysis which a covered agency is re-
quired to conduct by this chapter" and inserting "a
proposed rule or interim final rule for which a cov-
ered agency is required to conduct an initial regu-
latory flexibility analysis by this chapter"; and
(2) in subsection (d)—
(A) in paragraph (2), by striking "and" at
the end;
(B) in paragraph (3), by striking the pe-
riod at the end and inserting a semicolon; and
(C) by adding at the end the following:
