## CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Authorizing the printing of the 26th edition of the pocket  
version of the Constitution of the United States.

1       *Resolved by the Senate (the House of Representatives*  
2       *concurring),*

3       **SECTION 1. POCKET VERSION OF THE CONSTITUTION OF**  
4       **THE UNITED STATES.**

5       (a) IN GENERAL.—The 26th edition of the pocket  
6       version of the Constitution of the United States shall be  
7       printed as a Senate document under the direction of the  
8       Joint Committee on Printing.

9       (b) ADDITIONAL COPIES.—In addition to the usual  
10      number, there shall be printed the lesser of—

11               (1) 480,500 copies of the document, of which  
12      255,500 copies shall be for the use of the House of  
13      Representatives, 200,000 copies shall be for the use

1 of the Senate, and 25,000 copies shall be for the use  
2 of the Joint Committee on Printing; or

3 (2) such number of copies of the document as  
4 does not exceed a total production and printing cost  
5 of \$226,250, with distribution to be allocated in the  
6 same proportion as described in paragraph (1), ex-  
7 cept that in no case shall the number of copies be  
8 less than 1 per Member of Congress.

9 (c) DISTRIBUTION.—The copies of the document  
10 printed for the use of the House of Representatives and  
11 the Senate under subsection (a) shall be distributed in ac-  
12 cordance with—

13 (1) a distribution plan approved by the chair  
14 and ranking minority member of the Committee on  
15 House Administration of the House of Representa-  
16 tives, in the case of the copies printed for the use  
17 of the House of Representatives; and

18 (2) a distribution plan approved by the chair  
19 and ranking minority member of the Committee on  
20 Rules and Administration of the Senate, in the case  
21 of the copies printed for the use of the Senate.
