JOINT RESOLUTION

Providing for congressional disapproval of the proposed transfer to the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia certain defense articles and services.

1 *Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives*
2 *of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That the issuance of an export license with respect to the
4 following proposed exports to the Kingdom of Saudi Ara-
5 bia is prohibited:

6 (1) The transfer of the following defense arti-
7 cles, including services and technical data, described
8 in Executive Communication 1418 (EC-1418) sub-
9 mitted to Congress pursuant to section 36(c) of the

1 Arms Export Control Act (22 U.S.C. 2776(c)) and
2 published in the Congressional Record on June 3,
3 2019: The proposed transfer of technical data and
4 defense services in order to provide technically quali-
5 fied personnel to advise and assist the Royal Saudi
6 Air Force (RSAF) in maintenance and training for
7 the RSAF F-15 fleet of aircraft.
