Reports Filed: Reports were filed today as follows:

H.R. 1140, to enhance the security operations of the Transportation Security Administration and stability of the transportation security workforce by applying the personnel system under title 5, United States Code, to employees of the Transportation Security Administration who provide screening of all passengers and property, and for other purposes, with an amendment (H. Rept. 116–398, Part 1);

H.R. 3701, to establish a statute of limitations for certain actions of the Securities and Exchange Commission, and for other purposes, with an amendment (H. Rept. 116–399);

H.R. 4742, to amend the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 to impose a tax on nicotine used in vaping, etc, with an amendment (H. Rept. 116–400);

H.R. 4716, to amend the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 to provide a safe harbor for high deductible health plans without a deductible for certain inhalers, with an amendment (H. Rept. 116–401);

H.R. 2339, to amend the Federal Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act with respect to the sale and marketing of tobacco products, and for other purposes, with an amendment (H. Rept. 116–402); and

H.R. 745, to amend the Ethics in Government Act of 1978 to provide for reform in the operations of the Office of Government Ethics, and for other

purposes, with an amendment (H. Rept. 116–403, Part 1). **Page H1168**
