**Public Bills and Resolutions Introduced:** 29 public bills, H.R. 6013–6041; and 3 resolutions, H. Con. Res. 93–94; and H. Res. 876, were introduced.

**Suspension—Proceedings Resumed:** The House agreed to suspend the rules and pass the following measure. Consideration began Wednesday, February 26th.

**Gold Star Families National Monument Extension Act:** H.R. 2819, amended, to extend the authority for the establishment of a commemorative work in honor of Gold Star Families, by a  $\frac{2}{3}$  yeas-and-nay vote of 407 yeas with none voting "nay", Roll No. 76;

**Page H1286**

Agreed to amend the title so as to read: "To extend the authority for the establishment of a commemorative work in honor of Gold Star Mothers Families, and for other purposes."

**Page H1286**

**Reversing the Youth Tobacco Epidemic Act:** The House passed H.R. 2339, to amend the Federal Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act with respect to the sale and marketing of tobacco products, by a yeas-and-nay vote of 213 yeas to 195 nays, Roll No. 78.

**Pages H1257–86, H1286–89**

Rejected the Walden motion to recommit the bill to the Committee on Energy and Commerce with instructions to report the same back to the House forthwith with an amendment, by a yeas-and-nay vote of 187 yeas to 220 nays, Roll No. 77.

**Pages H1286–89**

Pursuant to the Rule, an amendment in the nature of a substitute consisting of the text of Rules Committee Print 116–51, modified by the amendment printed in House Report 116–409, shall be considered as adopted, in lieu of the amendment in the nature of a substitute recommended by the Committee on Energy and Commerce now printed in the bill.

H. Res. 866, the rule providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 2339) was agreed to yesterday, February 27th.

**Meeting Hour:** Agreed by unanimous consent that when the House adjourns today, it adjourn to meet at 12 noon on Monday, March 2nd for Morning Hour debate.
