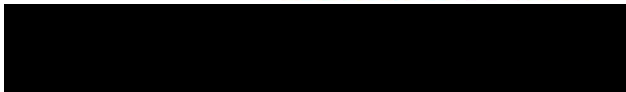


## CRST Chairman Harold C. Frazier



Harold C. Frazier, was born on November 23, 1966 to Sam Frazier (Itazipco) and Greta Takes The Knife (Mnicoujou) his Lakota name is Ta Hunska Luta (His Red Leggings).

Harold was born, raised and still resides in White Horse, SD. Harold has one daughter, two sons, and one grandchild. In 1985, Harold graduated from Cheyenne Eagle Butte High School in Eagle Butte, SD and went on to receive his AAS in Ag Business from Eastern Wyoming College in 1989. Harold worked for the Cheyenne River Gas Company and Cheyenne River Telephone Authority until 1998 when he was elected as District 4 Cheyenne River Sioux Tribal Councilman.

In 2002, Harold was elected at-large as the Cheyenne River Sioux Tribal Chairman, during his first chairmanship, he was elected as the Great Plains Area Vice-President of National Congress of American Indians (NCAI), as well as the honorary Sargent of Arms for the 2004 Democratic Convention. Following his term as Tribal Chairman, Harold was employed as the Program Specialist for the Black Hills Center for American Indian Health for a total of 8 years, while working as Program Specialist. Harold spoke before South Dakota's 91<sup>st</sup> Legislature for the State's first –ever, "State of the Tribes" address in January 2016.
