An amendment in the Nature of a Substitute to H.R. 3300 Offered by Rep. Walorski of Indiana

An amendment by Rep. Walorski which would prevent taxpayers with over \$1,000,000 in income from receiving the expansions of the child and dependent care tax credit provided by the bill, passed by a voice vote.

An amendment to the Amendment in the Nature of a Substitute to H.R. 3300 was offered by Rep. Rice of South Carolina.

An amendment by Rep. Rice, which would disallow the refundability of certain tax credits for 10 taxable years if the taxpayer makes a prior fraudulent claim or for 2 taxable years if the taxpayer makes a reckless claim, was defeated by a roll call vote of 16 yeas to 24 nays.
