## A BILL

To direct the Secretary of the Interior to develop a plan for the removal of the monument to Robert E. Lee at the Antietam National Battlefield, and for other purposes.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4       This Act may be cited as the “Robert E. Lee Statue  
5       Removal Act”.

6       **SEC. 2. REMOVAL PLAN FOR MONUMENT.**

7       Not later than 90 days after the date of the enact-  
8       ment of this Act, the Secretary of the Interior shall de-

1 velop a plan for the removal of the monument to Robert  
2 E. Lee at the Antietam National Battlefield.

3 **SEC. 3. REPORT.**

4 Not later than 120 days after the date of the enact-  
5 ment of this Act, the Secretary of the Interior shall submit  
6 to the Committee on Natural Resources of the House of  
7 Representatives and the Committee on Energy and Nat-  
8 ural Resources of the Senate, and make publicly available,  
9 a report describing the plan required under section 2 and  
10 a timeline for the removal of the monument in accordance  
11 with that plan.
