A BILL

To authorize the Secretary of Health and Human Services to carry out a pilot program to improve community-based care infrastructure.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. PILOT PROGRAM TO IMPROVE COMMUNITY-**
4 **BASED CARE INFRASTRUCTURE.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary of Health and
6 Human Services may award grants to qualified teaching
7 health centers (as defined in section 340H of the Public
8 Health Service Act (42 U.S.C. 256h)) and behavioral
9 health care centers (as defined by the Secretary, to include
10 both substance abuse and mental health care facilities) to

1 support the improvement, renovation, or modernization of
2 infrastructure at such centers, including to address
3 COVID–19 and other subsequent public health crises.

4 (b) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—To carry
5 out this section, there is authorized to be appropriated
6 \$500,000,000 for the period of fiscal years 2022 through
7 2026.
