## AN ACT

To amend the Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2021, to correct a provision on the prohibition on the use of a reverse auction, and for other purposes.

### 1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

- 2 This Act may be cited as the "Construction Con-
- 3 sensus Procurement Improvement Act of 2021".
- 4 SEC. 2. AMENDMENT.
- 5 Section 402 of title IV of division U of the Consoli-
- 6 dated Appropriations Act, 2021, is amended to read as
- 7 follows:
- 8 "Prohibition on use of a reverse auction for the
- 9 AWARD OF A CONTRACT FOR COMPLEX, SPECIAL-
- 10 IZED, OR SUBSTANTIAL DESIGN AND CONSTRUCTION
- 11 SERVICES
- 12 "Sec. 402.
- 13 "(a) FINDINGS.—Congress makes the following find-
- 14 ings:
- "(1) In contrast to a traditional auction in
- which the buyers bid up the price, sellers bid down
- 17 the price in a reverse auction.
- 18 "(2) Reverse auctions, while providing value for
- 19 the vast majority of Federal acquisitions, including
- 20 certain construction-related acquisitions, are limited
- 21 in value for complex, specialized, or substantial de-
- sign and construction services.
- 23 "(b) Reverse Auction Defined.—In this section,
- 24 the term 'reverse auction' means, with respect to any pro-
- 25 curement by an executive agency, a real-time auction gen-
- 26 erally conducted through an electronic medium among two

- 1 or more offerors who compete by submitting bids for a
- 2 supply or service contract, or a delivery order, task order,
- 3 or purchase order under the contract, with the ability to
- 4 submit revised lower bids at any time before the closing
- 5 of the auction.
- 6 "(c) Prohibition.—
- 7 "(1) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 270 days
- 8 after the date of the enactment of this section, the
- 9 Federal Acquisition Regulation shall be amended to
- prohibit the use of reverse auctions for awarding
- 11 contracts for complex, specialized, or substantial de-
- sign and construction services.
- 13 "(2) Applicability to acquisitions above
- 14 THE SIMPLIFIED ACQUISITION THRESHOLD.—The
- prohibition on reverse auctions for complex, special-
- ized, or substantial design and construction services
- shall apply only to acquisitions above the simplified
- acquisition threshold (SAT) for construction and de-
- sign services pursuant to part 36 of the Federal Ac-
- quisition Regulation.
- 21 "(d) Rulemaking for Complex, Specialized, or
- 22 Substantial Services.—Not later than 180 days after
- 23 the date of the enactment of this section, the Federal Ac-
- 24 quisition Regulatory Council shall promulgate a definition

- 1 of complex, specialized, or substantial design and con-
- 2 struction services, which shall include—
- 3 "(1) site planning and landscape design;
- 4 "(2) architectural and engineering services (as
- 5 defined in section 1102 of title 40, United States
- 6 Code);
- 7 "(3) interior design;
- 8 "(4) performance of substantial construction
- 9 work for facility, infrastructure, and environmental
- 10 restoration projects; and
- 11 "(5) construction or substantial alteration of
- public buildings or public works.
- 13 "(e) Rule of Construction.—Nothing in this sec-
- 14 tion shall be construed to restrict the use of reverse auc-
- 15 tions for the procurement of other goods and services ex-
- 16 cept as specifically provided for under this section.
- 17 "(f) Report.—Not later than two years after the
- 18 date of the enactment of this section, the Administrator
- 19 of General Services shall submit to the Committee on
- 20 Homeland Security and Governmental Affairs of the Sen-
- 21 ate and the Committee on Oversight and Reform of the
- 22 House of Representatives a report on the effectiveness of
- 23 this section in delivering complex, specialized, or substan-
- 24 tial design and construction services to the United States
- 25 Government.".

### 1 SEC. 3. DETERMINATION OF BUDGETARY EFFECTS.

- 2 The budgetary effects of this Act, for the purpose of
- 3 complying with the Statutory Pay-As-You-Go Act of 2010,
- 4 shall be determined by reference to the latest statement
- 5 titled "Budgetary Effects of PAYGO Legislation" for this
- 6 Act, submitted for printing in the Congressional Record
- 7 by the Chairman of the House Budget Committee, pro-
- 8 vided that such statement has been submitted prior to the
- 9 vote on passage.
