A BILL

To amend the Temporary Reauthorization and Study of the Emergency Scheduling of Fentanyl Analogues Act to extend until September 2021, a temporary order for fentanyl-related substances.

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Extending Temporary
5 Emergency Scheduling of Fentanyl Analogues Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. EXTENSION OF TEMPORARY ORDER FOR**
2 **FENTANYL-RELATED SUBSTANCES.**

3 Effective as if included in the enactment of the Tem-
4 porary Reauthorization and Study of the Emergency
5 Scheduling of Fentanyl Analogues Act (Public Law 116–
6 114), section 2 of such Act (Public Law 116–114) is
7 amended by striking “May 6, 2021” and inserting “Sep-
8 tember 30, 2021”.

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
