3 **SECTION 1. EMERGENCY RELIEF.**

4 Section 125(d) of title 23, United States Code, is
5 amended by adding at the end the following:

1 “(6) REPEATEDLY DAMAGED FACILITIES.—An
2 application submitted under this section for the per-
3 manent repair or reconstruction of a repeatedly
4 damaged facility shall include consideration and in-
5 corporation of feasible and economically justifiable
6 betterments, including protective features, to in-
7 crease the resilience of such facility.”.
