- 8 (1) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 1 year after 9 the date of the enactment of this Act, the Commis-10 sion shall adopt rules in the proceeding initiated in 11 the Notice of Proposed Rulemaking in the matter of 12 Protecting Against National Security Threats to the 13 Communications Supply Chain through the Equip-14 ment Authorization Program (ET Docket No. 21– 15 232; FCC 21-73; adopted June 17, 2021), in ac-16 cordance with paragraph (2), to update the equip-
 - (2) UPDATES REQUIRED.—In the rules adopted under paragraph (1), the Commission shall clarify that the Commission will no longer review or approve any application for equipment authorization for equipment that is on the list of covered communications equipment or services published by the Commission under section 2(a) of the Secure and Trusted Communications Networks Act of 2019 (47 U.S.C. 1601(a)).

5	ment authorization granted before the date on

9	(B) RULE OF CONSTRUCTION.—Nothing in
10	this section may be construed to prohibit the
11	Commission, other than in the rules adopted
12	under paragraph (1), from—
13	(i) examining the necessity of review
14	or revocation of any equipment authoriza-
15	tion on the basis of the equipment being
16	on the list described in paragraph (2); or
17	(ii) adopting rules providing for any
18	such review or revocation.
19	(b) Definition.—In this section, the term "Com-
20	mission'' means the Federal Communications Commission.
