

In the Senate of the United States,

June 22, 2022.

Resolved, That the bill from the House of Representatives (H.R. 4346) entitled “An Act making appropriations for Legislative Branch for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2022, and for other purposes.”, do pass with the following

AMENDMENT:

Strike all after the enacting clause and insert the following:

1 *That the following sums are appropriated, out of any*
2 *money in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated, for the*
3 *fiscal year ending September 30, 2022, and for other pur-*
4 *poses, namely:*

11 TITLE III

12 GENERAL PROVISIONS—THIS ACT

13 SEC. 301. Each amount appropriated or made avail-
 14 able by this Act is in addition to amounts otherwise appro-
 15 priated for the fiscal year involved.

16 SEC. 302. No part of any appropriation contained in
 17 this Act shall remain available for obligation beyond the
 18 current fiscal year unless expressly so provided herein.

19 SEC. 303. Unless otherwise provided for by this Act,
 20 the additional amounts appropriated by this Act to appro-
 21 priations accounts shall be available under the authorities
 22 and conditions applicable to such appropriations accounts
 23 for fiscal year 2022.

24 SEC. 304. Each amount provided by this Act is des-
 25 ignated by Congress as being for an emergency requirement

1 *pursuant to section 4001(a)(1) and section 4001(b) of S.*
2 *Con. Res. 14 (117th Congress), the concurrent resolution on*
3 *the budget for fiscal year 2022.*

4 *This Act may be cited as the “Supreme Court Security*
5 *Funding Act of 2022”.*
