**AN ACT**

To direct the Comptroller General of the United States to submit a report to Congress on case management personnel turnover of the Federal Emergency Management Agency, and for other purposes.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2        This Act may be cited as the “FEMA Caseworker  
3    Accountability Act”.

4 **SEC. 2. REPORT ON STAFF TURNOVER.**

5        Not later than 90 days after the date of enactment  
6    of this Act, the Comptroller General of the United States  
7    shall submit to Congress a report containing—

8                (1) the turnover rate for case management per-  
9    sonnel of the Federal Emergency Management  
10   Agency;

11               (2) the average and median length of employ-  
12    ment for the personnel described in paragraph (1);

13               (3) the steps that the Agency is taking, or  
14    plans to take, to lower the rate of turnover for the  
15   personnel described in paragraph (1);

16               (4) the number of personnel of the Agency that  
17    is detailed to work disaster recovery and then return  
18    to such personnel’s full time assignment after a dis-  
19    aster, disaggregated by full-time, part-time, tem-  
20    porary, and contract personnel; and

21               (5) the average time and median length of the  
22    rotations of personnel described in paragraph (4)  
23    and how often rotations and reassignment of per-  
24    sonnel occur for each disaster recovery position and

1       function, disaggregated by full-time, part-time, tem-  
2       porary, and contract personnel.
