A BILL

To amend the Energy Policy Act of 2005 to require reporting
relating to certain cost-share requirements.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Cost-Share Account-
5 ability Act of 2022”.

6 **SEC. 2. REPORTING REQUIREMENTS.**

7 Section 988 of the Energy Policy Act of 2005 (42
8 U.S.C. 16352) is amended by adding at the end the fol-
9 lowing:

10 “(g) REPORTING.—Not later than 120 days after the
11 enactment of the Cost-Share Accountability Act of 2022,
12 and at least quarterly thereafter, the Secretary shall sub-
13 mit to the Committee on Science, Space, and Technology
14 and Committee on Appropriations of the House of Rep-
15 resentatives and the Committee on Energy and Natural
16 Resources and the Committee on Appropriations of the
17 Senate, and shall make publicly available, a report on the
18 use by the Department during the period covered by the
19 report of the authority to reduce or eliminate cost-sharing
20 requirements provided by subsections (b)(3) or (c)(2).”.

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
