- 10 (1) consolidate Matters for Congressional Con-
- sideration from the Government Accountability Of-
- fice in one report organized by policy topic that in-
- cludes the amount of time such Matters have been
- unimplemented and submit such report to congres-
- sional leadership and the oversight committees of
- each House;
- 17 (2) with respect to the annual letters sent by
- the Comptroller General to individual agency heads
- and relevant congressional committees on the status
- of unimplemented priority recommendations, identify
- any additional congressional oversight actions that

- lating to such implementation;
