 - 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

1SECTION 1. INSTALLATION OF PLAQUE COMMEMORATING2SLAVE REBELLION ON ST. JOHN.

3 (a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 1 year after the date of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary of the 4 5 Interior shall install, in an appropriate location in the area of the Ram Head trail at the peak of Ram Head in the 6 7 Virgin Islands National Park on St. John, United States 8 Virgin Islands, a suitable plaque to commemorate the 9 slave rebellion that began on St. John on November 23, 10 1733.

11 (b) CONTENTS OF PLAQUE.—The plaque installed12 under subsection (a) shall include information regarding—

13 (1) important facts about the slave rebellion14 that began on St. John in 1733;

(2) the collective suicide that occurred during
the slave rebellion in the vicinity of Ram Head on
St. John in 1734; and

(3) the significance of the slave rebellion to the
 history of St. John, the United States Virgin Is lands, and the United States.
