AN ACT

To amend the Small Business Act to modify the requirements relating to the evaluation of the subcontracting plans of certain offerors, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2 This Act may be cited as the “Strengthening Subcon-
3 tracting for Small Businesses Act of 2022”.

4 **SEC. 2. EVALUATION OF SUBCONTRACTING PLANS.**

5 Section 8(d)(4)(G) of the Small Business Act (15
6 U.S.C. 637(d)(4)(G)) is amended—

7 (1) in the matter preceding clause (i), by strik-
8 ing “bundled contract” and all that follows through
9 “for subcontracting” and inserting “contract that
10 includes a subcontracting plan required under this
11 paragraph”; and

12 (2) in clause (i), by striking “the rate provided
13 under the subcontracting plan for small business
14 participation” and inserting “the description in the
15 subcontracting plan of the extent to which the offer-
16 or proposes to use small business concerns as sub-
17 contractors (at any tier)”.
