A BILL

To amend the Public Health Service Act to codify certain recommendations made by the Government Accountability Office with respect to the Department of Health and Human Services and cybersecurity, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Department of Health
5 and Human Services Cybersecurity Coordination Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. STRENGTHENING CYBERSECURITY AT DEPART-**
2 **MENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES.**

3 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 2811(b) of the Public
4 Health Service Act (42 U.S.C. 300hh–10(b)) is amended
5 by adding at the end the following:

6 “(8) CYBERSECURITY.—With respect to cyber-
7 security:

8 “(A) Monitor, evaluate, and report on the
9 progress and performance of the Government
10 Coordinating Council’s Cybersecurity Working
11 Group and HHS Cybersecurity Working Group.

12 “(B) Ensure that authorizing Federal offi-
13 cials review and approve the charter describing
14 how the HHS Cybersecurity Working Group
15 will facilitate collaboration with the HHS Chief
16 Information Security Officer Council, Contin-
17 uous Monitoring and Risk Scoring Working
18 Group, and Cloud Security Working Group.

19 “(C)(i) Finalize written agreements that
20 include a description of how the Government
21 Coordinating Council’s Cybersecurity Working
22 Group will collaborate with advisory bodies fo-
23 cused on cybersecurity.

24 “(ii) Identify the roles and responsibilities
25 of the Government Coordinating Council’s Cy-
26 bersecurity Working Group.

1 “(iii) Monitor and update the written
2 agreements on a regular basis.

3 “(iv) Ensure that authorizing Federal offi-
4 cials leading the working group approve the fi-
5 nalized agreements.

6 “(D) Update the charter for the Joint
7 Healthcare and Public Health Cybersecurity
8 Working Group for the current fiscal year and
9 ensure that authorizing officials leading the
10 working group review and approve the updated
11 charter.”.

12 (b) **ADDITIONAL CYBERSECURITY COORDINATION.**—
13 Subtitle A of title XXVIII of the Public Health Service
14 Act (42 U.S.C. 300hh et seq.) is amended by adding at
15 the end the following:

16 **“SEC. 2804. CYBERSECURITY COORDINATION.**

17 “The Secretary shall—

18 “(1) monitor, evaluate, and report on the
19 progress and performance of the HHS Chief Infor-
20 mation Security Officer Council, Continuous Moni-
21 toring and Risk Scoring Working Group, and Cloud
22 Security Working Group; and

23 “(2) regularly monitor and update written
24 agreements describing how the HHS Chief Informa-
25 tion Security Officer Council, Continuous Monitoring

1 and Risk Scoring Working Group, and Cloud Secu-
2 rity Working Group will facilitate collaboration, and
3 ensure that authorizing Federal officials review and
4 approve the updated agreements under section
5 2811(b)(8)(C).”.

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
