A BILL

To amend title 18, United States Code, to provide that robbery of armored cars constitutes bank robbery, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Justice for Armored
5 Car Crew Members Act of 2022”.

6 **SEC. 2. ROBBERY OF ARMORED CARS.**

7 Section 2113 of title 18, United States Code, is
8 amended—

1 (1) in subsection (f), by inserting before the pe-
2 riod at the end the following: “, and any armored
3 car or armored car company building”; and

4 (2) by adding at the end the following:

5 “(i) The term “armored car” means a vehicle used
6 by an armored car company (as such term is defined in
7 section 5(2) of the Armored Car Industry Reciprocity Act
8 of 1993 (15 U.S.C. 5904)) for the purposes described in
9 subparagraph (B) of such section 5(2) (15 U.S.C.
10 5904(2)(B)).

11 “(j) The term ‘armored car company building’ means
12 a building used by an armored car company for purposes
13 of engaging in the business of the armored car company.”.

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
