A BILL

To amend title 23, United States Code, to encourage affordable and accessible classroom-based driving instruction and behind-the-wheel training in highway safety programs, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Developing Robust In-
5 vestments in Vehicle Education for Roadway Safety Act”
6 or the “DRIVERS Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. HIGHWAY SAFETY PROGRAMS.**

2 Section 402(m)(2)(B)(x) of title 23, United States
3 Code, is amended—

4 (1) by striking “improve teen knowledge
5 about”;

6 (2) in subclause (I)—

7 (A) by inserting “improve teen knowledge
8 about” before “safe driving”; and

9 (B) by striking “and” at the end;

10 (3) in subclause (II)—

11 (A) by inserting “prepare teens for” before
12 “State graduated driving”;

13 (B) by inserting “classroom-based driving
14 instruction and” before “behind-the-wheel”; and

15 (C) by striking the period at the end and
16 inserting “; and”; and

17 (4) by adding at the end the following:

18 “(III) provide programming for
19 which affordability and accessibility
20 are considered in its implementa-
21 tion.”.

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
