## RESOLUTION

Of inquiry directing the Administrator of the Small Business Administration to transmit certain documents to the House of Representatives relating to the designation of the Small Business Administration as a voter registration agency.

1       *Resolved*, That the Administrator of the Small Busi-  
2       ness Administration is directed to transmit to the House  
3       of Representatives, not later than 14 days after the date  
4       of the adoption of this resolution, copies of any document,  
5       memorandum, correspondence, and other communication  
6       or any portion of any such communication, that refers or

1 relates to the Small Business Administration seeking des-  
2 ignations under section 7(a)(1) of the National Voter Reg-  
3 istration Act (52 U.S.C. 20506(a)(1)) to perform voter  
4 registration activities, including the following:

5           (1) Any documents and communications related  
6 to the decision of the Administrator to seek such  
7 designations.

8           (2) Any application materials submitted by the  
9 Administration for such a designation.

10           (3) Any documents and communications related  
11 to identifying or explaining the statutory authorities  
12 under which the Administration may carry out voter  
13 registration activities pursuant to such a designa-  
14 tion.

15           (4) Any documents and communications related  
16 to identifying or explaining the statutory authorities  
17 under which the Administration may share informa-  
18 tion relating to an election with any individual or en-  
19 tity outside of the Administration.

20           (5) Any documents and communications ref-  
21 erencing the mission of the Administration and the  
22 decision of the Administrator to seek such a designa-  
23 tion.

24           (6) Any documents and communications related  
25 to the funding required for the Administration to

1 carry out voter registration activities pursuant to  
2 such designations.

3 (7) Any documents and communications related  
4 to third-party organizations assisting the Adminis-  
5 tration with carrying out voter registration activities  
6 pursuant to such a designation.

7 (8) Any documents and communications related  
8 to State officials assisting the Administration with  
9 carrying out voter registration activities pursuant to  
10 such a designation.

11 (9) Any documents and communications related  
12 to requests from specific States to the Administrator  
13 for the Administration to carry out voter registra-  
14 tion activities pursuant to a designation by such  
15 State under section 7(a)(1) of the National Voter  
16 Registration Act (52 U.S.C. 20506(a)(1)).

17 (10) Any documents and communications re-  
18 lated to consideration of the subchapter III of chapter  
19 73 of title 5, United States Code, with respect to  
20 such a designation and training implemented by the  
21 Administration to safeguard against violations of  
22 such subchapter when carrying out voter registration  
23 activities pursuant to such a designation.
