Mr. MCGOVERN, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

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## RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 4502) making appropriations for the Departments of Labor, Health and Human Services, and Education, and related agencies for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2022, and for other purposes; and for other purposes.

1       *Resolved*, That upon adoption of this resolution it  
2 shall be in order to consider in the House the bill (H.R.  
3 4502) making appropriations for the Departments of  
4 Labor, Health and Human Services, and Education, and  
5 related agencies for the fiscal year ending September 30,

1 2022, and for other purposes. All points of order against  
2 consideration of the bill are waived. An amendment in the  
3 nature of a substitute consisting of the text of Rules Com-  
4 mittee Print 117-12, modified by the amendment printed  
5 in part A of the report of the Committee on Rules accom-  
6 panying this resolution, shall be considered as adopted.  
7 The bill, as amended, shall be considered as read. All  
8 points of order against provisions in the bill, as amended,  
9 are waived. The previous question shall be considered as  
10 ordered on the bill, as amended, and on any further  
11 amendment thereto, to final passage without intervening  
12 motion except: (1) one hour of debate equally divided and  
13 controlled by the chair and ranking minority member of  
14 the Committee on Appropriations or their respective des-  
15 ignees; (2) the further amendments described in section  
16 2 of this resolution; (3) the amendments en bloc described  
17 in section 3 of this resolution; and (4) one motion to re-  
18 commit.

19       SEC. 2. After debate pursuant to the first section of  
20 this resolution, each further amendment printed in part  
21 B of the report of the Committee on Rules not earlier con-  
22 sidered as part of amendments en bloc pursuant to section  
23 3 of this resolution shall be considered only in the order  
24 printed in the report, may be offered only by a Member  
25 designated in the report, shall be considered as read, shall

1 be debatable for the time specified in the report equally  
2 divided and controlled by the proponent and an opponent,  
3 may be withdrawn by the proponent at any time before  
4 the question is put thereon, shall not be subject to amend-  
5 ment, and shall not be subject to a demand for division  
6 of the question.

7       SEC. 3. It shall be in order at any time after debate  
8 pursuant to the first section of this resolution for the chair  
9 of the Committee on Appropriations or her designee to  
10 offer amendments en bloc consisting of further amend-  
11 ments printed in part B of the report of the Committee  
12 on Rules accompanying this resolution not earlier disposed  
13 of. Amendments en bloc offered pursuant to this section  
14 shall be considered as read, shall be debatable for 30 min-  
15 utes equally divided and controlled by the chair and rank-  
16 ing minority member of the Committee on Appropriations  
17 or their respective designees, shall not be subject to  
18 amendment, and shall not be subject to a demand for divi-  
19 sion of the question.

20       SEC. 4. All points of order against the further amend-  
21 ments printed in part B of the report of the Committee  
22 on Rules or amendments en bloc described in section 3  
23 of this resolution are waived.

24       SEC. 5. House Resolution 188, agreed to March 8,  
25 2021 (as most recently amended by House Resolution

1 508, agreed to June 30, 2021), is amended by striking  
2 "July 30, 2021" each place it appears and inserting (in  
3 each instance) "September 22, 2021".

4 SEC. 6. (a) At any time through the legislative day  
5 of Friday, July 30, 2021, the Speaker may entertain mo-  
6 tions offered by the Majority Leader or a designee that  
7 the House suspend the rules as though under clause 1 of  
8 rule XV with respect to multiple measures described in  
9 subsection (b), and the Chair shall put the question on  
10 any such motion without debate or intervening motion.

11 (b) A measure referred to in subsection (a) includes  
12 any measure that was the object of a motion to suspend  
13 the rules on the legislative day of July 26, 2021, or July  
14 27, 2021, in the form as so offered, on which the yeas  
15 and nays were ordered and further proceedings postponed  
16 pursuant to clause 8 of rule XX.

17 (c) Upon the offering of a motion pursuant to sub-  
18 section (a) concerning multiple measures, the ordering of  
19 the yeas and nays on postponed motions to suspend the  
20 rules with respect to such measures is vacated to the end  
21 that all such motions are considered as withdrawn.

22 SEC. 7. Notwithstanding clause 8 of rule XX, further  
23 proceedings on a vote by the yeas and nays on the question  
24 of adoption of a motion that the House suspend the rules  
25 offered on the legislative day of July 26, 2021, or July

1 27, 2021, may continue to be postponed through the legis-  
2 lative day of September 22, 2021.
