Mr. MCGOVERN, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 3967) to improve health care and benefits for veterans exposed to toxic substances, and for other purposes.

1 *Resolved*, That upon adoption of this resolution it
2 shall be in order to consider in the House the bill (H.R.
3 3967) to improve health care and benefits for veterans ex-
4 posed to toxic substances, and for other purposes. All
5 points of order against consideration of the bill are waived.
6 An amendment in the nature of a substitute consisting
7 of the text of Rules Committee Print 117–33, modified

1 by the amendment printed in part A of the report of the
2 Committee on Rules accompanying this resolution, shall
3 be considered as adopted. The bill, as amended, shall be
4 considered as read. All points of order against provisions
5 in the bill, as amended, are waived. The previous question
6 shall be considered as ordered on the bill, as amended,
7 and on any further amendment thereto, to final passage
8 without intervening motion except: (1) one hour of debate
9 equally divided and controlled by the chair and ranking
10 minority member of the Committee on Veterans' Affairs
11 or their respective designees; (2) the further amendments
12 described in section 2 of this resolution; (3) the amend-
13 ments en bloc described in section 3 of this resolution; and
14 (4) one motion to recommit.

15 SEC. 2. After debate pursuant to the first section of
16 this resolution, each further amendment printed in part
17 B of the report of the Committee on Rules not earlier con-
18 sidered as part of amendments en bloc pursuant to section
19 3 of this resolution shall be considered only in the order
20 printed in the report, may be offered only by a Member
21 designated in the report, shall be considered as read, shall
22 be debatable for the time specified in the report equally
23 divided and controlled by the proponent and an opponent,
24 may be withdrawn by the proponent at any time before
25 the question is put thereon, shall not be subject to amend-

1 ment, and shall not be subject to a demand for division
2 of the question.

3 SEC. 3. It shall be in order at any time after debate
4 pursuant to the first section of this resolution for the chair
5 of the Committee on Veterans' Affairs or his designee to
6 offer amendments en bloc consisting of further amend-
7 ments printed in part B of the report of the Committee
8 on Rules accompanying this resolution not earlier disposed
9 of. Amendments en bloc offered pursuant to this section
10 shall be considered as read, shall be debatable for 20 min-
11 utes equally divided and controlled by the chair and rank-
12 ing minority member of the Committee on Veterans' Af-
13 fairs or their respective designees, shall not be subject to
14 amendment, and shall not be subject to a demand for divi-
15 sion of the question.

16 SEC. 4. All points of order against the further amend-
17 ments printed in part B of the report of the Committee
18 on Rules or amendments en bloc described in section 3
19 of this resolution are waived.

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
