Mr. KELLY (for himself and Ms. SINEMA) introduced the following bill; which
was read twice and referred to the Committee on Energy and Natural
Resources

A BILL

To modify the boundary of the Sunset Crater Volcano Na-
tional Monument in the State of Arizona, and for other
purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Sunset Crater Volcano
5 National Monument Boundary Adjustment Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. DEFINITIONS.**

7 In this Act:

8 (1) **FEDERAL LAND.**—The term “Federal land”
9 means the approximately 97.71 acres of Forest

1 Service land identified as “Proposed transfer from
 2 USDA Forest Service to National Park Service” on
 3 the Map.

4 (2) MAP.—The term “Map” means the map en-
 5 titled “Sunset Crater Volcano National Monument
 6 Draft Proposed Boundary Adjustment”, numbered
 7 039/80,053d, and dated January 2021.

8 (3) MONUMENT.—The term “Monument”
 9 means the Sunset Crater Volcano National Monu-
 10 ment established by Presidential Proclamation 1911
 11 (54 U.S.C. 320301 note; 46 Stat. 3023) and redes-
 12 ignated by section 15 of the Smith River National
 13 Recreation Area Act (Public Law 101–612; 104
 14 Stat. 3222).

15 (4) SECRETARY.—The term “Secretary” means
 16 the Secretary of the Interior, acting through the Di-
 17 rector of the National Park Service.

18 **SEC. 3. SUNSET CRATER VOLCANO NATIONAL MONUMENT**

19 **BOUNDARY MODIFICATION.**

20 (a) TRANSFER OF ADMINISTRATIVE JURISDICTION
 21 TO NATIONAL PARK SERVICE.—Administrative jurisdic-
 22 tion over the Federal land is transferred from the Forest
 23 Service to the National Park Service.

1 (b) MAP AVAILABILITY.—The Map shall be on file
2 and available for inspection in the appropriate offices of
3 the National Park Service.

4 (c) BOUNDARY MODIFICATION.—The boundary of
5 the Monument is modified to include the Federal land.

6 (d) ADMINISTRATION.—Subject to valid existing
7 rights, the Secretary shall administer the Federal land
8 added to the Monument under subsection (a)—
9 (1) as part of the Monument; and
10 (2) in accordance with applicable laws (includ-
11 ing regulations).

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
