A BILL

To shorten the extension, and the amount, of Federal Pandemic Unemployment Compensation in order to get Americans back to work.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Get Americans Back
5 To Work Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. SHORTENING OF THE EXTENSION, AND REDUCING**
2 **THE AMOUNT, OF FEDERAL PANDEMIC UN-**
3 **EMPLOYMENT COMPENSATION.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 2104(e)(2) of the CARES
5 Act (15 U.S.C. 9023(e)(2)) is amended by striking “Sep-
6 tember 6, 2021” and inserting “June 30, 2021”.

7 (b) AMOUNT.—Section 2104(b)(3)(A) of such Act
8 (15 U.S.C. 9023(b)(3)(A)) is amended—

9 (1) in clause (ii), by striking “September 6,
10 2021” and inserting “May 31, 2021”; and

11 (2) by adding at the end the following:

12 “(iii) For weeks of unemployment
13 ending after May 31, 2021, and ending on
14 or before June 30, 2021, \$150.”.

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
