#### AN ACT

- To require the Director of the Office of Management and Budget to establish or otherwise provide an artificial intelligence training program for the acquisition workforce, and for other purposes.

#### 1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

2	This Act may be cited as the "Artificial Intelligence					
3	Training for the Acquisition Workforce Act" or the "A					
4	Training Act".					
5	SEC. 2. ARTIFICIAL INTELLIGENCE TRAINING PROGRAMS.					
6	(a) Definitions.—In this section:					
7	(1) AI.—The term "AI" has the meaning given					
8	the term "artificial intelligence" in section 238(g) of					
9	the John S. McCain National Defense Authorization					
10	Act for Fiscal Year 2019 (10 U.S.C. 2358 note).					
11	(2) AI TRAINING PROGRAM.—The term "					
12	2 training program" means the training program e					
13	tablished under subsection (b)(1).					
14	(3) COVERED WORKFORCE.—The term "covered					
15	workforce" means—					
16	(A) employees of an executive agency who					
17	are responsible for—					
18	(i) program management;					
19	(ii) the planning, research, develop-					
20	ment, engineering, testing, and evaluation					
21	of systems, including quality control and					
22	assurance;					
23	(iii) procurement and contracting;					
24	(iv) logistics; or					
25	(v) cost estimating; and					

1	(B) other personnel of an executive agency				
2	designated by the head of the executive agency				
3	to participate in the AI training program.				
4	(4) Director.—The term "Director" means				
5	the Director of the Office of Management and Budg-				
6	et.				
7	(5) Executive agency.—The term "executive				
8	agency"—				
9	(A) has the meaning given the term in sec-				
10	tion 133 of title 41, United States Code; and				
11	(B) does not include—				
12	(i) the Department of Defense or a				
13	component of the Department of Defense;				
14	or				
15	(ii) the National Nuclear Security Ad-				
16	ministration or a component of the Na-				
17	tional Nuclear Security Administration.				
18	(b) Requirement.—				
19	(1) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 1 year after				
20	the date of enactment of this Act, and not less fre-				
21	quently than annually thereafter, the Director, in co-				
22	ordination with the Administrator of General Serv-				
23	ices and any other person determined relevant by the				
24	Director, shall develop and implement or otherwise				

1	provide an AI training program for the covered					
2	workforce.					
3	(2) Purpose.—The purpose of the AI training					
4	program shall be to ensure that the covered work-					
5	force has knowledge of the capabilities and risks as					
6	sociated with AI.					
7	(3) Topics.—The AI training program shall in-					
8	clude information relating to—					
9	(A) the science underlying AI, including					
10	how AI works;					
11	(B) introductory concepts relating to the					
12	technological features of artificial intelligence					
13	systems;					
14	(C) the ways in which AI can benefit the					
15	Federal Government;					
16	(D) the risks posed by AI, including dis-					
17	crimination and risks to privacy;					
18	(E) ways to mitigate the risks described in					
19	subparagraph (D), including efforts to create					
20	and identify AI that is reliable, safe, and trust-					
21	worthy; and					
22	(F) future trends in AI, including trends					
23	for homeland and national security and innova-					
24	tion.					

1	(4) UPDATES.—Not less frequently than once					
2	every 2 years, the Director shall update the Al					
3	training program to—					
4	(A) incorporate new information relating					
5	to AI; and					
6	(B) ensure that the AI training program					
7	continues to satisfy the requirements under					
8	paragraph (3).					
9	(5) FORMAT.—The Director is encouraged to					
10	develop and implement or otherwise include unde					
11	the AI training program interactive learning with—					
12	(A) technologists;					
13	(B) scholars; and					
14	(C) other experts from the private, public					
15	and nonprofit sectors.					
16	(6) Metrics.—The Director shall ensure the					
17	existence of a means by which to—					
18	(A) understand and measure the participa-					
19	tion of the covered workforce; and					
20	(B) receive and consider feedback from					
21	participants in the AI training program to im-					
22	prove the AI training program.					

- 1 (7) SUNSET.—Effective 10 years after the date
- 2 of enactment of this Act, this section shall have no
- 3 force or effect.
