Mr. Kaine (for himself, Mr. Tester, and Ms. Cortez Masto) introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Health, Education, Labor, and Pensions

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## A BILL

To improve the Iraq and Afghanistan Service Grant and the Children of Fallen Heroes Grant.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3   **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4       This Act may be cited as the “Protecting Our Gold Star Families Education Act”.

6   **SEC. 2. IMPROVING IRAQ AND AFGHANISTAN SERVICE GRANT AND CHILDREN OF FALLEN HEROES GRANT.**

9       (a) TECHNICAL AMENDMENT RELATING TO IRAQ AND AFGHANISTAN SERVICE GRANT AND CHILDREN OF

1 FALLEN HEROES GRANT.—Part A of title IV of the High-  
2 er Education Act of 1965 (20 U.S.C. 1070 et seq.), as  
3 amended by section 703 of the FAFSA Simplification Act  
4 (title VII of division FF of Public Law 116–260), is  
5 amended—

6 (1) in section 401—

7 (A) in subsection (c)—

8 (i) in paragraph (2)—

9 (I) by striking subparagraph (A);

10 and

11 (II) by redesignating subparagraphs (B) and (C) as subparagraphs  
12 (A) and (B), respectively;

13 (ii) in paragraph (3)(A), by striking  
14 “(2)(B)(i)” and inserting “(2)(A)(i);”

15 (iii) by redesignating paragraph (5) as  
16 paragraph (7); and

17 (iv) by inserting after paragraph (4)  
18 the following:

19 “(5) PREVENTION OF DOUBLE BENEFITS.—No  
20 eligible student described in paragraph (2) may con-  
21 currently receive a grant under both this subsection  
22 and subsection (b).

23 “(6) TERMS AND CONDITIONS.—The Secretary  
24 shall award grants under this subsection in the same

1 manner and with the same terms and conditions, in-  
2 cluding the length of the period of eligibility, as the  
3 Secretary awards Federal Pell Grants under sub-  
4 section (b), except that—

5 “(A) the award rules and determination of  
6 need applicable to the calculation of Federal  
7 Pell Grants under subsection (b)(1) shall not  
8 apply to grants made under this subsection; and

9 “(B) the maximum period determined  
10 under subsection (d)(5) shall be determined by  
11 including all grants made under this section re-  
12 ceived by the eligible student and all grants so  
13 received under subpart 10 before the effective  
14 date of this subsection.”; and

15 (2) by striking section 420R (20 U.S.C.  
16 1070h).

17 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by  
18 subsection (a) shall take effect as if included in section  
19 703 of the FAFSA Simplification Act (title VII of division  
20 FF of Public Law 116–260) and subject to the effective  
21 date of section 701(b) of such Act.

22 (c) TRANSITION.—The Secretary shall take such  
23 steps as are necessary to transition from the Iraq and Af-  
24 ghanistan Service Grant program under subpart 10 of  
25 part A of title IV of the Higher Education Act of 1965

1 (20 U.S.C. 1070h), as in effect on the day before the effec-  
2 tive date of this section, and the provision of Federal Pell  
3 Grants under section 401(c) of the Higher Education Act  
4 of 1965 (20 U.S.C. 1070a(c)), as amended by the FAFSA  
5 Simplification Act and this Act.
