A BILL

To amend section 7014 of the Elementary and Secondary Education Act of 1965 to advance toward full Federal funding for impact aid, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Advancing Toward Im-

5 pact Aid Full Funding Act of 2022”.

6 **SEC. 2. AMENDMENT TO ESEA.**

7 Section 7014 of the Elementary and Secondary Edu-

8 cation Act of 1965 (20 U.S.C. 7714) is amended by strik-

1 ing subsections (a) through (d) and inserting the fol-
2 lowing:

3 “(a) PAYMENTS FOR FEDERAL ACQUISITION OF
4 REAL PROPERTY.—For the purpose of making payments
5 under section 7002, there are authorized to be appro-
6 priated—

7 “(1) \$87,313,000 for fiscal year 2023;

8 “(2) \$98,313,000 for fiscal year 2024;

9 “(3) \$109,313,000 for fiscal year 2025;

10 “(4) \$120,313,000 for fiscal year 2026; and

11 “(5) \$131,313,000 for fiscal year 2027.

12 “(b) BASIC SUPPORT PAYMENTS; PAYMENTS FOR
13 HEAVILY IMPACTED LOCAL EDUCATIONAL AGENCIES.—
14 For the purpose of making payments under section
15 7003(b), there are authorized to be appropriated—

16 “(1) \$1,544,242,000 for fiscal year 2023;

17 “(2) \$1,734,242,000 for fiscal year 2024;

18 “(3) \$1,924,242,000 for fiscal year 2025;

19 “(4) \$2,114,242,000 for fiscal year 2026; and

20 “(5) \$2,304,242,000 for fiscal year 2027.

21 “(c) PAYMENTS FOR CHILDREN WITH DISABIL-
22 ITIES.—For the purpose of making payments under sec-
23 tion 7003(d), there are authorized to be appropriated—

24 “(1) \$57,316,000 for fiscal year 2023;

25 “(2) \$66,316,000 for fiscal year 2024;

1 “(3) \$75,316,000 for fiscal year 2025;

2 “(4) \$84,316,000 for fiscal year 2026; and

3 “(5) \$93,316,000 for fiscal year 2027.

4 “(d) CONSTRUCTION PAYMENTS.—For the purpose
5 of making payments under section 7007, there are author-
6 ized to be appropriated—

7 “(1) \$20,656,000 for fiscal year 2023;

8 “(2) \$23,906,000 for fiscal year 2024;

9 “(3) \$27,156,000 for fiscal year 2025;

10 “(4) \$30,406,000 for fiscal year 2026; and

11 “(5) \$33,656,000 for fiscal year 2027.”.
