SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

- This Act may be cited as the "RECA Extension Act
- 3 of 2022".
- 4 SEC. 2. REAUTHORIZATION OF THE RADIATION EXPOSURE
- 5 COMPENSATION ACT.
- 6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 3(d) of the Radiation Ex-
- 7 posure Compensation Act (Public Law 101–426; 42
- 8 U.S.C. 2210 note) is amended—
- 9 (1) by striking the first sentence and inserting
- "The Fund shall terminate on the date that is 2
- 11 years after the date of enactment of the RECA Ex-
- tension Act of 2022."; and
- 13 (2) by striking "22-year period" and inserting
- 14 "2-year period".
- 15 (b) LIMITATION ON CLAIMS.—Section 8(a) of the Ra-
- 16 diation Exposure Compensation Act (Public Law 101–
- 17 426; 42 U.S.C. 2210 note) is amended by striking "within
- 18 22 years after the date of the enactment of the Radiation
- 19 Exposure Compensation Act Amendments of 2000" and
- 20 inserting "not later than 2 years after the date of enact-
- 21 ment of the RECA Extension Act of 2022".
