A BILL

To amend the River and Harbor Act of 1958 to improve provisions relating to invasive species management, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Aquatic Invasive Spe-

5 cies Control Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. INVASIVE SPECIES MANAGEMENT.**

7 Section 104 of the River and Harbor Act of 1958

8 (33 U.S.C. 610) is amended—

9 (1) in subsection (b)(2)(A)(ii)—

1 (A) by striking “\$50,000,000” and insert-
 2 ing “\$75,000,000”; and

3 (B) by striking “2024” and inserting
 4 “2028”; and

5 (2) in subsection (g)(2)—

6 (A) in subparagraph (A)—

7 (i) by striking “water quantity or
 8 water quality” and inserting “water quan-
 9 tity, water quality, or ecosystems”; and

10 (ii) by inserting “the Lake Erie
 11 Basin, the Ohio River Basin,” after “the
 12 Upper Snake River Basin,”; and

13 (B) in subparagraph (B), by inserting “,
 14 hydrilla (*Hydrilla verticillata*),” after
 15 “*angustifolia*”).

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
