A BILL

To amend the Not Invisible Act of 2019 to extend, and provide additional support for, the activities of the Department of the Interior and the Department of Justice Joint Commission on Reducing Violent Crime Against Indians, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF, AND ADDITIONAL SUPPORT**
 2 **FOR THE ACTIVITIES OF, THE DEPARTMENT**
 3 **OF THE INTERIOR AND THE DEPARTMENT OF**
 4 **JUSTICE JOINT COMMISSION ON REDUCING**
 5 **VIOLENT CRIME AGAINST INDIANS.**

6 (a) EXTENSION OF COMMISSION AND ACTIVITIES OF
 7 THE COMMISSION.—Section 4 of the Not Invisible Act of
 8 2019 (Public Law 116–166; 134 Stat. 767) is amended—

9 (1) in subsection (c)(2)(B), by striking “18
 10 months after the enactment” and inserting “36
 11 months after the date of enactment”; and

12 (2) in subsection (e), by striking “2 years” and
 13 inserting “42 months”.

14 (b) ADDITIONAL SUPPORT FOR ACTIVITIES OF COM-
 15 MISSION.—Section 4(b) of the Not Invisible Act of 2019
 16 (Public Law 116–166; 134 Stat. 767) is amended—

17 (1) in the subsection heading, by inserting “;
 18 OPERATION” after “MEMBERSHIP”; and

19 (2) by adding at the end the following:

20 “(7) FUNDING.—The Secretary of the Interior
 21 and the Attorney General shall contribute the funds
 22 necessary for the operation of the Commission.

23 “(8) GIFTS.—The Commission may accept and
 24 use gifts or donations of services or property from
 25 Indian tribes or Tribal entities, academic institu-
 26 tions, or other not-for-profit organizations as it con-

- 1 siders necessary to carry out the duties of the Com-
- 2 mission described in subsection (c).”.

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
