A BILL

To make a technical correction to the ALS Disability
Insurance Access Act of 2019.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. RETROACTIVE ACCESS TO SOCIAL SECURITY**

4 **DISABILITY BENEFITS INDIVIDUALS WITH**

5 **AMYOTROPHIC LATERAL SCLEROSIS (ALS).**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 2(b) of the ALS Dis-
7 ability Insurance Access Act of 2019 (Public Law 116–
8 250) is amended by striking “applications for disability
9 insurance benefits filed after the date of enactment of this
10 Act” and inserting “applications for disability insurance

1 benefits approved after the date that is 5 months before
2 the date of enactment of this Act”.

3 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
4 this section shall take effect as if included in the enact-
5 ment of the ALS Disability Insurance Access Act of 2019
6 (Public Law 116–250).

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
