SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE. This Act may be cited as the "Sunshine Protection 2 Act of 2021". 3 SEC. 2. MAKING DAYLIGHT SAVING TIME PERMANENT. 5 (a) Repeal of Temporary Period for Daylight Saving Time.—Section 3 of the Uniform Time Act of 1966 (15 U.S.C. 260a) is hereby repealed. 8 (b) ADVANCEMENT OF STANDARD TIME.— 9 (1) In general.—The second sentence of sub-10 section (a) of section 1 of the Act of March 19, 11 1918 (commonly known as the "Calder Act") (15 U.S.C. 261), is amended— 12 (A) by striking "4 hours" and inserting "3 13 14 hours"; 15 (B) by striking "5 hours" and inserting "4 16 hours"; (C) by striking "6 hours" and inserting "5 17 18 hours"; (D) by striking "7 hours" and inserting "6 19 20 hours"; (E) by striking "8 hours" and inserting 21 22 "by 7 hours"; (F) by striking "9 hours" and inserting "8 23 24 hours"; (G) by striking "10 hours;" and inserting 25

"9 hours;";

5	(2) STATE EXEMPTION.—Such section is fur-					
6	ther amended by—					
7	(A) redesignating subsection (b) as sub-					
8	section (e); and					
9	(B) inserting after subsection (a) the fol-

11	"(b) STANDARD TIME FOR CERTAIN STATES AND					
12	Areas.—The standard time for a State that has exempted					
13	itself from the provisions of section 3(a) of the Uniform					
14	Time Act of 1966 (15 U.S.C. 260a(a)), as in effect on					
15	the day before November 5, 2023, pursuant to such sec-					
16	tion or an area of a State that has exempted such area					
17	from such provisions pursuant to such section shall be,					
18	as such State considers appropriate—					
19	"(1) the standard time for such State or area,					
20	as the case may be, pursuant to subsection (a) of					
21	this section; or					
22	"(2) the standard time for such State or area,					
23	as the case may be, pursuant to subsection (a) of					
24	this section as it was in effect on the day before No-					
25	vember 5, 2023.".
