CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Establishing deadlines for the Joint Committee of Congress on the Library to approve or deny the statue of the Reverend William Franklin “Billy” Graham, Jr., for placement in the National Statuary Hall.

1 *Resolved by the Senate (the House of Representatives*
2 *concurring)*, That the Joint Committee of Congress on the
3 Library shall approve or deny—

4 (1) the full-sized clay model and pedestal design
5 of a statue of the Reverend William Franklin
6 “Billy” Graham, Jr., not later than 30 days after
7 the State of North Carolina submits to the Architect
8 of the Capitol photographs of the model from all 4

1 sides, the dimensions of the statue and pedestal, en-
2 gineering drawings of the pedestal, the anticipated
3 weight of the completed statue and pedestal, and the
4 text of any proposed inscriptions; and

5 (2) the completed statue of the Reverend Wil-
6 liam Franklin “Billy” Graham, Jr., not later than
7 30 days after the State of North Carolina submits
8 to the Architect of the Capitol photographs of the
9 completed statue and pedestal from all 4 sides, the
10 dimensions of the statue and pedestal, the final
11 weight of the statue and pedestal, and the text of
12 any inscriptions.

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
