3 **SECTION 1. HONORING THE LAST SURVIVING MEDAL OF**
4 **HONOR RECIPIENT OF WORLD WAR II.**

5 In recognition of Hershel Woodrow “Woody” Wil-
6 liams, the last surviving recipient of the Medal of Honor

1 for acts performed during World War II, his remains shall
2 be permitted to lie in honor in the rotunda of the Capitol
3 on Thursday, July 14, 2022, in order to honor the Great-
4 est Generation and the more than 16,000,000 men and
5 women who served in the Armed Forces of the United
6 States from 1941 to 1945. The Architect of the Capitol,
7 under the direction of the President pro tempore of the
8 Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives,
9 shall take all necessary steps for the accomplishment of
10 that purpose.
