- H.R. 2278 (**Rep. Gerald Connolly**), To authorize the Secretary of the Interior to designate the September 11th National Memorial Trail, and for other purposes.
- <u>H.R. 2444</u> (Resident Commissioner Jenniffer González-Colón), To establish Fort San Gerónimo del Boquerón in Puerto Rico as an affiliated area of the National Park System, and for other purposes. *Fort San Gerónimo Preservation Act*.
