CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Authorizing the use of Emancipation Hall in the Capitol
Visitor Center for a historic ceremony to commemorate
Slavery Remembrance Day.

1 *Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate*
2 *concurring),*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This resolution may be cited as the “Original Resolu-
5 tion to Commemorate Slavery Remembrance Day in
6 Emancipation Hall”.

1 **SEC. 2. USE OF EMANCIPATION HALL FOR CEREMONY TO**
2 **COMMEMORATE SLAVERY REMEMBRANCE**
3 **DAY.**

4 (a) AUTHORIZATION.—Emancipation Hall in the
5 Capitol Visitor Center is authorized to be used on August
6 10, 2024, for a ceremony to commemorate Slavery Re-
7 membrance Day.

8 (b) PREPARATIONS.—Physical preparations for the
9 conduct of the ceremony described in subsection (a) shall
10 be carried out in accordance with such conditions as the
11 Architect of the Capitol may prescribe.

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
