A BILL

To amend chapter 63 of title 5, United States Code, to
modify the accumulation of annual leave for use in suc-
ceeding years for administrative law judges.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. LIMITS ON ACCUMULATION OF ANNUAL LEAVE**

4 **FOR ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGES.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 6304(f)(1) of title 5,
6 United States Code, is amended—

7 (1) in subparagraph (G), by striking “; or” and
8 inserting a semicolon;

1 (2) in the first subparagraph (H) (relating to a
2 position in the Library of Congress), by striking the
3 period at the end;

4 (3) by redesignating the second subparagraph
5 (H) (relating to a position in the United States Se-
6 cret Service Uniformed Division) as subparagraph
7 (I);

8 (4) in subparagraph (I), as so redesignated, by
9 striking the period and inserting “; or”; and

10 (5) by adding at the end the following new sub-
11 paragraph:

12 “(J) an administrative law judge position
13 under section 3105.”.

14 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by
15 this section shall take effect on the first day of the first
16 applicable pay period beginning on or after the date that
17 is 30 days after the date of enactment of this Act.

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
