AN ACT

To modify the prohibition on recognition by United States courts of certain rights relating to certain marks, trade names, or commercial names.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2 This Act may be cited as the “No Stolen Trademarks
3 Honored in America Act of 2023”.

4 **SEC. 2. MODIFICATION OF PROHIBITION.**

5 Section 211 of the Department of Commerce and Re-
6 lated Agencies Appropriations Act, 1999 (as contained in
7 section 101(b) of division A of Public Law 105–277; 112
8 Stat. 2681–88) is amended—

9 (1) in subsection (a)(2)—

10 (A) by inserting “or entity of the executive
11 branch” after “U.S. court”;

12 (B) by striking “by a designated national”;
13 and

14 (C) by inserting before the period “that
15 was used in connection with a business or as-
16 sets that were confiscated unless the original
17 owner of the mark, trade name, or commercial
18 name, or the bonafide successor-in-interest has
19 expressly consented”;

20 (2) in subsection (b)—

21 (A) by inserting “or entity of the executive
22 branch” after “U.S. court”; and

23 (B) by striking “by a designated national
24 or its successor-in-interest”;

25 (3) by redesignating subsection (d) as sub-
26 section (e);

(5) in subsection (e), as so redesignated, by striking “In this section:” and all that follows through “(2) The term” and inserting “In this section, the term”.
