AN ACT

To amend the Grand Ronde Reservation Act, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2 This Act may be cited as the “Grand Ronde Reserva-
3 tion Act Amendment of 2023”.

4 **SEC. 2. GRAND RONDE RESERVATION ACT AMENDMENT.**

5 Section 1(d) of Public Law 100–425 (commonly
6 known as the “Grand Ronde Reservation Act”; 102 Stat.
7 1594; 108 Stat. 4566) is amended—

8 (1) in paragraph (1), by striking “lands within
9 the State of Oregon” and inserting “the 84 acres
10 known as the Thompson Strip”;

11 (2) by redesignating paragraph (2) as para-
12 graph (3); and

13 (3) by inserting after paragraph (1) the fol-
14 lowing:

15 “(2) GAMING PROHIBITION.—Any real property
16 obtained by the Tribes as part of a land claim settle-
17 ment approved by the United States, including any
18 real property purchased with funds granted as part
19 of any land claim settlement, shall not be eligible, or
20 used, for any class II gaming or class III gaming
21 under the Indian Gaming Regulatory Act (25 U.S.C.
22 2701 et seq.) (as those terms are defined in section
23 4 of that Act (25 U.S.C. 2703)).”.

1 SEC. 3. TREATY RIGHTS OF FEDERALLY RECOGNIZED

2 **TRIBES.**

3 Nothing in this Act, or an amendment made by this
4 Act, shall be construed to enlarge, confirm, adjudicate, af-
5 fect, or modify any treaty right of an Indian Tribe (as
6 defined in section 4 of the Indian Self-Determination and
7 Education Assistance Act (25 U.S.C. 5304)).
